

E-QUIP DIPLOMA ESSAY FAQ'S

All the materials (lectures, bibliographies and essay titles) are on the website. Let me know if you cannot find anything.

I can lend you books if you cannot acquire / borrow them locally (UK and Ireland only). There will be a postal charge (billed when you have completed each term), which you should claim back from the parish or community.

Once you have read the first term's lectures and are ready to complete your first two chosen essays for Year 1, please submit to me an outline (NOT the full text - bullet points please) of your first essay so you can be aware of what is required (I will give you feedback).

Footnotes should be included for cited sources. Please use the format employed in the lectures themselves. Sources can be from electronic or paper media. Include a bibliography at the end please.

Do not quote large chunks of text from sources in the text of your essay. No credit will be given for this. The essays should be 1500 to 2000 words long, no less and no more.


